Where it goes:

Triple T collects the recyclables and takes them to the Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) in Rutland, run by Casella Waste Systems. There the materials are separated and baled, then trucked to manufacturers who use them as a source material.

## WSWMD Transfer Station Brookline is a member of the Windham Solid Waste Management District which gives residents access to the WSWMD transfer station and services. (The District also provides planning services to the town including the regional Solid Waste Implementation Plan.) Location: Hours: 327 Old Ferry Rd, Brattleboro 7-3 weekdays; 8-1 Saturday

Access:

Open to residents and businesses of any WSWMD member town. Annual access permit is \$40 and runs from July 1 to June 30 each year. Stickers go on sale May 1 each year. A \$15 day-pass is also available.
