

The Town of Brookline's Post Storm Right of Way Clean Up Policy

The Town of Brookline Vermont has adopted this post - storm clean up policy to ensure safe passage for all vehicles on town roads following significant weather conditions which may have caused a build of debris, water, ice or snow to fall in or near traveled roads and culverts. While landowners are encouraged to clear away and keep wood that either falls on their property or is cut down by Green Mountain Power, it is the town's responsibility to maintain a safe right of way which includes keeping ditches and culverts clear of materials that may cause additional erosion, ice buildup and or flooding. When possible, residents will be notified that post storm clean up will be occurring within the town limits.

Policy introduced on Wednesday June 21, 2023 during a Regular Selectboard Meeting which was duly warned and posted.
