Discussion on priorities for the Old School Building MERP 1 assessment that is planned to be conducted on Feb 13<sup>th</sup> at 11am

Assessor: Michael Doheny from Bureau Veritas (Contracted by State BGS)

Priorities for School Building (two buildings) to be highlighted with the assessor and to make sure they are included in audit report:

- More efficient water heater, get an opinion about instant/on demand and hybrid
- More efficient boiler replacement
- The 1927 building needs insulation to the 'cap' to bring it up to over an r-50.
- Weatherization of all the windows

Open points for discussion with the assessor:

- Would he think a blower test would be helpful?
- Is there a way to replace the old ventilation system with energy efficient air filters?
- Any opportunities for solar panels, energy storage, net metering

The Energy committee anticipated that blower test may be excluded from a MERP 1 assessment, but that SEVCA could be contacted to conduct a free assessment at a separate time.
