

**The following By Laws have been adopted by the commissioners of the
RiverSide Cemetery in Brookline VT
July 24, 2025**

Article 1 The Commissioners shall choose from their own number a Chairman, who shall preside at all meetings of the Board. A Secretary who shall keep a record of all business done at its meetings, an Agent to sell and convey lots by deed in the name of said town of Brookline and have the care of said Cemetery, and see that it is kept in order .

Article 2 The Commission shall elect a person to serve as the Sexton. The Sexton will be in charge of digging graves and see that all extra dirt and stones are removed from the lot at once. The fee for burial of an urn is \$100.00. The fee for burial of a coffin is \$600.00

Article 3 All graves must be dug so as to leave sufficient space at the head for gravestones or monument.

Article 4 Only flush foot stones and/or corner stones may be set at a grave, but nothing in this article shall prevent the setting of markers at the head of the grave.

Article 5 All deeds must be processed and recorded at the time of purchase by the Town Clerk.

Article 6 No grave sites are to be exhumed without the written consent of the Cemetery Commission.

Article 7 No trees, shrubs, bushes, running vines, nor anything that will spread will be permitted to be set out in this cemetery, but nothing in this article shall prevent the setting out of suitable flowers. Seasonal decorations must be removed before the end of April to facilitate proper maintenance.

Article 8 The grass and weeds must be cut and cleared from all the lots and grounds in said cemetery at such time as the Commissioners may direct.

Article 9 A Cemetery Space is 40 inches by 10 feet and intended to hold one single casket with a vault or up to 4 cremation vessels. Names are to be recorded on the headstone.

Article 10 It is restricted that only current residents or previous property owners are permitted to purchase cemetery space in the Riverside Cemetery.

Article 11 These Bylaws may be altered or amended at any meeting of the Board by a majority of all the Commissioners.

The foregoing bylaws were unanimously adopted by a full board of the Cemetery Commissioners of the Town of Brookline Vermont at a warned meeting held on:
